



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ThinStone™ is a great product for residential and commercial projects. Here, we'll answer some of the most frequently asked questions regarding our ThinStone™ product.

How much does Thinstone™ weigh?

On average, it weighs under 15 pounds per square foot.

What's the difference between linear and square feet?

Linear feet is a 12" measurement of length. Length in inches divided by 12 = linear feet. Square feet is a measurement of area. Length in feet x width in feet = square feet.

How many square feet or linear feet come on a pallet?

ThinStone[™] flats have 240 square feet on a pallet. Each pallet has 18 layers and each layer is 13.33 square feet. You are able to order the exact quantity you need even if it means breaking a full pallet. ThinStone[™] corners are sold by the linear foot (LF) in 50 LF or 100 LF crates. You can order the exact quantity of corners you need even if it means breaking a full crate.

Is ThinStone™ only available to ship to nearby locations?

Because we have dealers spread throughout the country, we can ship ThinStone™ anywhere in the U.S. and abroad. We offer multiple methods for shipping based on location and the total weight of your order.

Where can I view ThinStone™ locally?

Contact us for the nearest dealer.

Is there a thickness variation on ThinStone™ flats?

Yes, ThinStone™ flats typically range from ¾"-1.5" thick.

Is the stone available in other formats?

Yes. It is available in our standard formats (mosaic, square cut, ledge cut, and strip cut) as well as custom cuts. For more information on the ThinStone™ options we have available, read our blog at www.connecticutstone.com/blog.

How is ThinStone™ installed?

Is there color variation in the material?

Yes. Since ThinStone™ is 100% natural stone, you will see color variation in the material. If you're interested in viewing what we have available, ask a specialist for current lot photos and samples to confirm your selection.

What is the difference between ThinStone™ and cultured stone?

ThinStone™ is 100% natural stone quarried from the earth. It will not fade or disintegrate over time. All ThinStone™ is natural stone, so colors will vary from piece to piece. Cultured stone is a man-made product that is primarily created from cement and pigment. When exposed to sun and harsh weather, cultured stone will fade over time.

What is the difference between building stone veneer and ThinStone™?

The main difference is thickness. Building stone veneer averages 4"-6" in thickness. ThinStone™ averages ¾"-1.5" in thickness. This leads to weight variations and different requirements during installation.

Where is ThinStone™ manufactured?

ThinStone™ is manufactured in the United States
- Connecticut, to be exact!

What is the origin of the stone?

We are the originators of ThinStone[™]. About 98% of our ThinStone[™] products are quarried domestically with the majority coming sourced in the Northeast.
